Timothy Burroughs is Executive Director of StopWaste, a public agency advancing sustainability in Alameda County. Timothy also serves as the Chair of CalRecycle's statewide SB 54 (plastic pollution prevention) Advisory Board, representing the interests of local governments as the state moves forward with developing and implementing regulations to reduce the volume and increase the recyclability of the plastic packaging entering our communities. He has over 19 years of experience working within public, community-serving agencies, including serving successively as the Manager of the Office of Energy & Sustainable Development, Chief Resilience Officer, and Director of the Department of Planning & Development at the City of Berkeley.
